ATMs provide a quick and convenient way to access your money, wherever you are. As accessible as they are, however, there are several key things to keep in mind when using an ATM in order to ensure your safety. At NCBA we value our customers' safety and as such would like to remind you of the following when using an ATM, whether here in Anguilla or abroad:

- If you decide to use the ATM after dark, choose one that is well lit and not in an isolated location.
- Try to avoid using an ATM by yourself, take someone you trust with you, or only use an ATM when others are around.
- Observe your surroundings before using the ATM. Look around to determine if anyone is sitting in a parked vehicle in the general area of the ATM location who may be a threat to you.
- Do not leave your car unlocked or engine running when leaving it to use the ATM.
- Before approaching the ATM ensure that there are no suspicious looking persons or activity around it.
- Have your card out and ready to use.
- Do not use the ATM if it appears to be damaged.
- Shield the screen and keyboard so anyone waiting to use the ATM cannot see you enter your PIN or transaction amount.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings throughout the entire transaction. Do not become so involved with your transaction that you are not aware of changing conditions in the area.
- After your transaction put your cash, card and receipt away immediately. Count your money later, and always keep your receipt

- As you leave the ATM, be aware of anything suspicious. If you think you are being followed, go to an area with a lot of people and call the police.
